Pursuant to •6 and § 11 of the Naval Air Station Brunswick, Maine Federal Facility Agreement dated October 19, 1990, as amended (FFA), the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the subject document. Although the Navy has not proposed to meet ARARs to the extent practicable in this document, it is a requirement of 40CFR 300.415 (i), the FFA, and EPA guidance OSWER directive 9360.3-01 and EPA will require the Navy meet ARARs to the extent practicable during this removal action. In addition, the Navy must notify the public and provide the public with the opportunity to review the administrative record for this action in accordance with 40CFR 300.415 (m) (2) and 40CFR 300.415 (m) (3), the FFA, and appropriate EPA guidance. EPA understands the Navy is in the process of revising the NASB Community Relations Plan and expects the Navy to meet these regulatory deadlines for publishing it.
