**SUBJECT: SITE 9 ACTION MEMO, DATED JUNE 25, 2007, FOR THE NAVAL AIR STATION,
BRUNSWICK (NASB), ME**

In response to your letter dated July 12, 2007, the Navy is revising the Site 9 Letter Work Plan (LWP) text to address EPA and MEDEP comments. The LWP will also be modified to state that the removal action will meet the appropriate ARARs to the extent practicable.

The Navy has formally notified the public of the planned restart of this removal action via a public notice; a copy of the newspaper publication is enclosed. We will continue to provide opportunities for community members to become more informed and to participate in the process through Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meetings, the current update to the Community Relations Plan, the NAS Brunswick Environmental Restoration News (newsletters), and by having access to the administrative record file for this as well as the other environmental restoration program efforts taking place at NASB.

PUBLIC NOTICE OF TIME CRITICAL REMOVAL ACTION AT SITE 9 (NEPTUNE DRIVE DISPOSAL AREA) NAVAL AIR STATION BRUNSWICK, MAINE

Purpose of this notice is to update the public about the Navy's progress in completing the Time Critical Removal Action (TCRA) of ash and soil contamination from Site 9 (Neptune Drive Disposal Site) and to assure the public that this Site 9 removal action is protective of human health and the environment.

Navy initiated the removal action in April 2006 to excavate landfilled ash and contaminated soil from a WWII-era incinerator located at Site 9 (Neptune Drive Disposal Area). The Navy is planning to continue with this removal action in August/September 2007.

Status reports on this removal action have been presented to the public during Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meetings. The next RAB is scheduled for Wednesday, October 17, 2007 beginning at 7 PM at the Parkwood Inn, Brunswick, ME. The public can access information on this and other Navy environmental clean-up efforts at the information repository in the Curtis Memorial Library, Brunswick, ME.
