**SUBJECT: REMEDIAL SCHEDULES FOR SITES 12 & 17 & MMRP SITES AND CHANGES  
RELATING TO BASE REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE (BRAC) ENVIRONMENTAL  
PROGRAM MANAGEMENT FOR NAVAL AIR STATION (NAS) BRUNSWICK, ME**

This letter has a two-fold purpose, to address your letters of January 23, 2006 and February 26, 2006, respectively, and to notify you of changes related to the environmental program for NAS Brunswick, under Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC). As discussed and agreed to during the conference call of March 10, 2006, we will provide the proposed remedial schedules for Sites 12 and 17 and the Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) sites requested in your letters, no later than April 17, 2006.

In accordance with the Naval Air Station Brunswick, Maine Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) signed October 19, 1990, as amended, Section VII, Project Managers, the BRAC Program Management Office Northeast (PMO NE) hereby assigns Mr. Orlando (Lonnie) Monaco the duties and responsibilities of the Remedial Project Manager (RPM) position. This assignment is a continuation of Mr. Monaco's RPM position prior to BRAC 2005. The PMO's responsibilities include BRAC environmental program management (priorities, funding and schedules) for the restoration program at NAS Brunswick.

As the BRAC Environmental Coordinator (BEC), Ms. Dawn Kincaid will be increasingly involved in the environmental program at NAS Brunswick. Some of her responsibilities include:


- Participate in Restoration Advisory Boards, coordinating Navy involvement
- Act as liaison to NAS Brunswick's BRAC Transition Coordinator on environmental matters

- Act as liaison/coordinator with installation personnel on closure-related environmental compliance matters
- Lead the BRAC Cleanup Team (BCT)
- In conjunction with the BCT, conduct a review of the environmental cleanup programs and implement necessary action plans
- Ensure a BRAC Cleanup Plan (BCP) is coordinated with the Community Reuse Plan and is prepared and updated as needed
- Implement environmental cleanup programs related to closure in an expeditious and cost effective manner
- Serve as Program Manager for the Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA)
- Sign correspondence and specifically delegated decision documents, including CERFA determination

Mr. Monaco will soon relocate to the PMO NE address so please direct all his future correspondence here. We will also soon notify you of his new telephone and facsimile number. Mr. Monaco's email address will still remain the same.
