Dear Mr. Simonson:

As we discussed on November 26, 1991, HALLIBURTON NUS is pursuing cost-effective methods of handling Site Investigation derived residues at the Calverton Activity. The October 18, 1991 to Ms. Debra Felton was faxed to you on November 27, 1991. This letter summarized the analytical results of testing for the materials inventoried in each of the drums.

Based on these findings, a request for proposal from the Navy to HALLIBURTON NUS indicated that the contents of twelve 55-gallon drums containing purge and decontamination water should be treated at a wastewater treatment plant prior to discharge; and the contents of twelve 55-gallon drums containing soils, considered to be relatively uncontaminated, can be spread onto the ground at the site. The 24 empty drums would then be either disposed of offsite and/or be reused.

The purpose of this letter is to request that:

- About 600 gallons of purge and decontamination water be discharged to the onsite wastewater treatment plant.
- Grumman Aerospace Corporation be asked if they would like to use the 24 empty drums at no cost to them. This would be more economical than paying a drum recycling firm a pickup and cleaning charge.


