

Dear Ms. Felton:

Because of the imminent start of the IAG negotiations for the Calverton facility between the USN, USEPA and NYSDEC, the technical lead for the site has been transferred to the Division of Hazardous Waste Remediation (Superfund) from the Division of Hazardous Substances Regulation (RCRA). The new NYSDEC project manager assigned to the site is David Pratt, who will continue to work and coordinate closely with the DHSR. Please direct all future correspondence to him.

I have asked Mary Logan of the USEPA about the adequacy of the work plans, for the Calverton fieldwork, and her answers were satisfactory except for that on the laboratory analysis of samples. The Superfund program, unlike that of RCRA, requires a TCL/TAL CLP analysis of at least all first round samples, and we need to ensure that this will occur. Is it possible that you call David Pratt or me (518) 457-3976) to discuss this? A telephone conference call with Mary Logan on this point is also desirable.
