MEMORANDUM

FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE TECHNICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE (TRC) FOR THE
INSTALLATION RESTORATION PROGRAM AT NAVAL WEAPONS INDUSTRIAL RESERVE
PLANT (NWIRP) CALVERTON, NEW YORK

Enclosed is the Navy's Draft RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI)
Addendum for NWIRP Calverton, NY. Please review the document and
forward any comments in writing on or before October 13, 1995.

This report is a supplement to the Final RFI Report dated August 1995,
and is being issued to disclose the results of a second round of
groundwater sampling. As stated in the RFI Workplan dated July 1993,
a second round of groundwater sampling was required to ascertain the
potential for time and seasonal fluctuations regarding groundwater
contamination.

The RFI Workplan had called for collecting groundwater samples during
both a "dry" and a "wet" period. The first round of samples was taken
during August 1994 and was to represent the "dry" period. The second
round was collected during March 1995 and was to represent the "wet"
period. However, climatological data from the JFK Airport for these
sampling events indicated that August 1994 was actually a wetter month
than normal (6.69 inches of precipitation) and March 1995 was actually
a drier month than normal (only 1.31 inches of precipitation).
Although the assumptions made in the workplan were reversed regarding
the "dry" and "wet" seasons, the intent of the workplan has still been
met.

No significant differences were noted when comparing the results of
both rounds of groundwater sampling events. As a result, there are no
significant changes to the conclusions which have been presented in
the Final RFI Report dated August 1995.
