

Dear Mr. Brayack:

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) is in receipt of your client's application for a Freshwater Wetlands permit to install a new water line, and we find it to be incomplete for the following items.

1) You must a site plan (5 copies) showing the proposal in relation to the freshwater wetland boundary line. DEC staff will flag or locate the wetland boundary and we will notify you when the wetland boundary has been delineated. The delineated wetland boundary line must be added to the site plan. The site plan must also depict the **"limits of clearing and ground disturbance"** verbatim, showing the perimeter of any proposed disturbance.

Five sets of site plans are required to be submitted when completed.

2) You must submit the \$50 application fee.

This application will remain incomplete until the above items are adequately addressed.
