Subj: INSTALLATION RESTORATION PROGRAM AT THE NAVAL WEAPONS
INDUSTRIAL RESERVE PLANT, CALVERTON, NEW YORK

1. The Department of the Navy has implemented an Installation Restoration (IR) Program to ensure facility compliance with the Comprehensive Environmental, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, and Executive Order 12580 as well as other applicable environmental laws and regulations.

2. The Navy will initiate a Site Investigation of Sites #1, #4, #6B and #6C, as identified in the Initial Assessment Study, at the Calverton facility on or about 1 March 1991. The Remedial Investigation (RI) phase for Sites #2 and #6A at Calverton is expected to begin at approximately the same time.

3. You are hereby advised that Grumman Aerospace Corporation may participate in the RI phase for Sites #2 and #6A at this time. It is requested that you formally accept or decline participation in the RI. Your decision not to participate will not preclude future participation in any remaining phase of the IR Program or investigations to be performed at any remaining sites. If you desire to participate, a meeting will be arranged to discuss any outstanding questions or issues. Your response in such regard is requested within 30 days of the date of this letter and should be sent to: Commander, Naval Air Systems Command, AIR-4222, Washington, D.C. 20361-4222.
