Dear Jeff:

I am enclosing a Draft Letter Workplan for the installation of a Pre-Design Pilot Recovery Test within the Fire Training Area (IR Site 2) and the Fuel Calibration Area (IR Site 6A) at NWIRP Calverton for your review. This draft workplan outlines the work anticipated to perform pilot recovery tests within each site in order to provide additional information that will be used to prepare final designs for the Free Product Recovery (FPR) systems.

This work is to be performed by the Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation, who is our Remedial Action Contractor (RAC). As shown on the schedule attached to the end of the workplan, Foster Wheeler is proposing to begin work on the pilot recovery tests sometime during the last week of February 1999. Therefore, I am requesting that any comments pertinent to this pilot work be forwarded to me as soon as possible. Final designs for the FPR systems are anticipated in May 1999 with system start up scheduled for late July 1999. Copies of the design and workplan for the actual FPR systems will also be forwarded to you for review.
