

Dear Mr. Selva:

This office requires the following procedure for monitoring the groundwater observation wells installed at the referenced locations.

1. The wells must be checked for the presence of floating product once per week for the first month of monitoring. If floating product is found, then the wells must be bailed immediately. The number of observation wells and the frequency of monitoring is subject to change based upon the amount of product being found.


2. If floating product is not found during the first month of monitoring, then the wells must be monitored for the presence of floating product once per month and for dissolved petroleum product constituents once every three (3) months. The well sampling must be performed in accordance with US EPA protocol. The well must be purged three to five times the volume of the well screen before a sample is collected. The samples are to be analyzed by a certified laboratory for the presence of Benzene, Toluene, Ethylbenzene, and Xylene using EPA Method 602, and for semi-volatiles using EPA Method 625.

3. If floating and dissolved product do not exist for twelve consecutive months, then the spill file will be reviewed for possible removal from our active list.

4. Monitoring reports must be submitted to this office on a monthly basis. An example sheet has been enclosed to illustrate the format of monitoring data which is required.

Please contact me at 751-7900, or 751-7401, if you have any questions. If no contact is made, then we will expect you to submit the required monitoring reports. If no observation well monitoring and sampling is performed, then this office will arrange for the necessary work to be performed. We will then seek reimbursement of costs plus appropriate penalties from you in accordance with Article Twelve of the New York State Navigation Law.
