The Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune has forwarded your letter of October 20, 1988 concerning RCRA/CERCLA Enforcement Action Strategy and we feel that a definition of roles is appropriate at this time.

This Command has been delegated the authority and responsibility to develop and negotiate the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) between EPA, North Carolina and the Marine Corps in the matter of MCB Camp Lejeune. As a result of this tasking, we will be working very closely with the installation staff to develop a draft agreement which should be available at the next Technical Review Committee meeting.
