

Enclosed please find the original Letter of Intent (LOI) to Execute the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) for the environmental restoration of the U. S. Department of Navy's (DON's) Camp LeJeune Military Reservation, Jacksonville, North Carolina. The LOI represents the official closing of negotiations by all Parties to the FFA and serves notice to the public that the FFA is ready for review and comment. EPA and the State are anticipating a meeting within the comment period to inform the public as to the purpose of the FFA.

As requested, the Regional Administrator has signed the LOI. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is forwarding the LOI for DON signature and final execution. LETTER OF INTENT TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), the North Carolina Department of Environment, Health and Natural Resources (DEHNR) and the U.S. Department of the Navy (DON) declare their intent to execute the Federal Facility Agreement (Agreement) for the U.S. Department of the Navy's Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, and Marine Corps Air Station, New River, North Carolina. The Parties agree that:

Within fifteen (15) days of the execution of this Letter, the USEPA shall: (1) publish this Letter of Intent to Execute the Agreement; and (2) make available for review by the public copies of the Agreement and all appendices.

The Parties shall accept written comments from the public for a period of forty-five (45) days following such Letter. In addition, the Parties will accept public comment at informal public meetings during this period, either in writing or orally. After the close of the comment period, the Parties will review such comments. The Parties will determine whether the comments disclose facts or considerations which indicate that the proposed Agreement is inappropriate, improper, or inadequate and shall take such action as is appropriate under Section XXXIV (Public Comment) of the Agreement. The Parties shall execute the Agreement when all necessary changes precipitated by public comments have been resolved as provided in Section XXXIV (Public Comment) of the Agreement.
