Agreement

Dear Mr. Butler:

Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, and MCB Camp Lejeune recommend a minor amendment to the Camp Lejeune Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA). This amendment addresses what constitutes official receipt of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and North Carolina Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources (DEHNR) review comments on primary and secondary documents.

MCB Camp Lejeune is required to submit revised documents within a specified time (i.e., 60 days, 30 days) of receipt of EPA and DEHNR comments. The FFA does not address what constitutes the official start date in instances in which the EPA and DEHNR comments are not received on the same date.

We propose the official start date is the date of receipt of the last comments received.

As discussed with you in our meeting of April 16, 1991, we consider this a "minor ministerial" change to the FFA which can be amended per FFA Section XXXV., AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT, by unanimous written agreement by the EPA, DEHNR, and MCB Camp Lejeune. We request your written response by May 10, 1991.
