

1. The subject Federal Facilities Environmental Compliance Profile has been reviewed as requested in the reference with the following comments:

CERCLA: Notification has been filed. NPL site on October 4, 1989. Initial site assessments have been completed for 76 sites. 28 sites will need RI/FS. Site assessments, start-up of RI/FS and community relations have been initiated under CERCLA. Major findings are upper aquifer contamination, surface soil contamination in some areas; possible sediment and fish contamination. Corrective action design will be complete by the end of July for the HPIA recovery system. Construction funds have been set aside for FY 90. Corrective action plan was advertised by the State in July 1990.
