The third bullet at the bottom of page 2-2 Of the Waste Management Plan, states that CH2MHill will supervise all IDW disposal at the WWTP. Rhea is responsible for proper operation of the treatment plant. Therefore, a Rhea representative should be present with all previously submitted paperwork to assure that the discharge is consistent with the reported disposal paperwork.

The third paragraph on page 3-1 states, "Where waste is collected in drums, one sample per 10 drums of each media [**or per monitoring well**] is required. Please add language similar to that in brackets."

The first paragraph at the top of page 4-3 discusses moving waste to Site 89. Site 89 is not a less than 90 day storage facility. Waste from Camp Geiger and GSRA should remain on site or be moved to a less than 90 day storage facility. Please remove the last sentence of this paragraph.

With discussion and agreement regarding the comments above the NC Superfund Section concurs with the attached Draft Waste Management Plan dated May 2009.

The first paragraph at the top of page 4-3 discusses moving waste to Site 89. Site 89 is not a less than 90 day storage facility. Waste from Camp Gator and GSA should remain on site or be moved to a less than 90 day storage facility. Please remove the last sentence of this paragraph.
