The NC Superfund Section has received and reviewed the Draft Preliminary Assessment /Site Inspection (PA/SI) Work Plan for the P-714 Fitness Center MILCON dated June 2010 and received for review on June 9, 2010. The Site is located at the Camp Lejeune Air Station of MCB Superfund Site, located in Jacksonville, NC.

Specific Comments:

1. Section 3.4.3 on page 3-18 states, "all purge & decon. water will be contained in 55 gallon steel drums, appropriately labeled, and temporarily staged at Parachute Tower Road." Do we have a TSD facility at Parachute Tower Road? If not, we need to store the drums at a base TSD facility preferably at the Air Station. Please make appropriate corrections.
2. The Division IH is in the process of reviewing the Health and Safety Plan. His comments will be forwarded when they are complete. The IH comments on the Health and Safety Plan can be incorporated at a later date as necessary.
