GENERAL COMMENTS:

PRAP and ROD

The Risk Assessment discussions should follow the Focused Remedial Investigation discussions. It is difficult to follow the logic that supports a no action decision by reading the text. The AQualitative Risk Assessment@ identifies COPC that should be addressed, however, the next section AProposed Response Action A recommends no action. The ASupplemental Groundwater Investigation@ and the ATemporary Well Delineation Study@ were conducted to address the COPCs. The rearrangement of the text will make this clear.

PRAP Comments

Page 2 - The photo at the bottom of the page is misidentified.

Page 6 - First paragraph, last sentence, an unclear statement.

Page 15 - last sentence add the public comment dates.

ROD Comments

Declaration - Change the Commanding General=s name.

Page 6 - last paragraph, duplicate contaminant listed.

Page 14 - last paragraph, first sentence, an unclear sentence.
