

**MARINE CORPS BASE (MCB), CAMP LEJEUNE INVITES
COMMENT AND PUBLIC MEETING PARTICIPATION ON THE
PROPOSED PLAN FOR OPERABLE UNIT (OU) No.2 AT
MARINE CORPS BASE , CAMP LEJEUNE, NORTH CAROLINA**

The U.S. Navy /Marine Corps announces the availability of the Proposed Plan for OU No. 2 at MCB, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina for public review and comment. The site does not pose any immediate harm to public health and the proposed plan outlines methods for soil and groundwater remediation.

OU No. 2 includes Site 6 (Storage Lots 201 and 203), Site 9 (Fire Fighting Training Pit at Piney Green Road), and Site 82 (Piney Green Road VOC Area). A total of five remedial action alternatives for groundwater and seven alternatives for soil were developed. The proposed alternative for shallow and deep groundwater is extraction, treatment and discharge. The proposed soil alternative is to treat one area of concern in situ via vapor extraction and to excavate and dispose the remaining contaminated soil at an offsite, permitted landfill.

MCB, Camp Lejeune will hold a public information meeting on August 17, 1993 at 7:00 p.m. at the Tarawa Terrace #1 Elementary School Gymnasium located on Tarawa Boulevard, near the intersection of Corbin Street and Lejeune Boulevard (Hwy. 24). This public information meeting will be held to describe the Proposed Plan for OU No.2.

The Navy/Marine Corps will hold a 30-day public comment period from August 23, 1993 to September 23, 1993. The public comment period will allow for public participation in the selection process. Comments postmarked after the period will not be considered. Comments received during the public comment period will be logged and will become part of the Administrative Record for the Installation Restoration Program at MCB Camp Lejeune. Comments and responses will be addressed in a Responsiveness Summary and published with the Final Record of Decision. Names of those who comment will not be included in the Responsiveness Summary but are subject to Freedom of Information Act requests. Written comments should be directed to:

**MARINE CORPS BASE (MCB),
CAMP LEJEUNE, ANNOUNCES THE FINAL RECORD OF
DECISION (ROD) FOR HADNOT POINT INDUSTRIAL AREA
(HPIA) SHALLOW GROUNDWATER AT MCB CAMP LEJEUNE,
NORTH CAROLINA**

The U.S. Navy/Marine Corps announces the signing of the Final Interim Remedial Action ROD for the Shallow Aquifer at the HPIA Operable Unit at MCB Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Prior to the signing of the ROD, a public meeting (May 14, 1992) and public comment period (May 14 to June 14, 1992) were held. No comments were received during the comment period.

A total of seven interim remedial action alternatives were developed to reduce the threat posed by the contaminated shallow groundwater aquifer at the HPIA. Subsequent actions are planned to fully address all of the impacted media at the site. The selected interim action is groundwater extraction, pretreatment, air stripping, carbon adsorption, discharge, and institutional controls. The design is completed and construction is scheduled to begin in Fiscal Year 1994 (October, 1993). This action is outlined in the ROD.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region IV, and the North Carolina Department of the Environment, Health, and Natural Resources concurred with the ROD. The ROD was signed by the Commanding General, MCB Camp Lejeune on September 23, 1992.
