The NC Superfund Section has received and reviewed the **Draft Community Involvement Plan** for the Camp Lejeune, MCB Superfund Site located in Jacksonville, NC. The following comments are offered for the Work Teams consideration. If you have any questions or comments please contact me at (919) 733-2801 ext. 341.

### General Comment

With the following exceptions the Draft Community Involvement Plan (CIP) appears to be in good order and contains appropriate details to aid in helping inform the local community about environmental issues and encourage them to participate in the CERCLA process as they are able.

### Specific Comments

1. Figure 2-1 identifies Site 73 as part of Operable Unit (OU) #9. As you know and as stated at the top of page 2-6, Site 73 is no longer part of OU#9 but is now part of OU#21. Please make appropriate changes on this and all Figures that depict Site 73 as part of OU#9.
2. The last paragraphs on page 3-7 and 3-10 states that community comment indicated that more outreach should be done, especially to on-base residents and employees. I strongly

agree with these comments. This is especially important in areas where residents and employees are impacted in any way by site investigation and remedial action.

3. Several local officials and organizations are noted as being notified about the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meetings, as on page 3-11, and in the mailing list as discussed on page 3-21. Do we also contact the Jacksonville Town Manager and the County Health Director about public meetings including the RAB meetings? If not we should always notify them about all future meetings related to environmental issues or health impacts.
4. The last sentence just before Table 3-2 on page 3-14 should be changed to reflect the following recommended language. "The following TRC and RAB Meetings have been held during the progress of MCB Camp Lejeune's IRP, in addition to Public Meetings and quarterly RAB Meetings since 2000". Please confirm these dates. I know that quarterly RAB meetings have been held since late 2002 that are not listed in table 3-2. Please change the language on page 3-14 to clarify this detail.
5. The public comment period should be changed in the "Topics Discussed" column of Table 3-2 near the top of page 3-15 to state the correct comment period for the 18 July 2001 Public Meeting.
6. The Remedial Investigation (RI) for Site 88 will be completed in 2004 not in 2003 as stated in the Site Status column on page 5 of Appendix A.
7. I contacted the Public Information Repositories as listed on page D-1 of Appendix D and the Librarians seemed to know about the older hard copies of the Administrative Record but did not seem to know about the newer documents on the **Web page**. This issue should quickly be addressed so that anyone who calls can immediately be directed to the right person that can assist them in locating the internet web page and encourage them to come to the library to look at the newer documents on the computer, provided for that purpose, if they wish.
8. The first paragraph on page D-1 states that quarterly RAB Meetings are held at 7:00 p.m. Since I have been working with the Camp Lejeune IR program the RAB Meetings have met at the college at 6:30 p.m. Public Meetings may be at 7:00 p.m. but not RAB Meetings. Please make appropriate corrections.
9. Typographical error at the top of page G-2.
