1. Appendix B, page 13: The last line appears to be incomplete. Please correct.
2. Section 2.5: The NC OSHA standard for 2,4,6-trinitrotoluene (TNT) is  $0.5 \text{ mg/m}^3$ , not  $1.5 \text{ mg/m}^3$  as listed in this section. Please note: The NC OSHA standards for airborne contaminants differ from the federal standards. If your copy of the NC OSHA standards is dated prior to April, 2003, the *federal* (not state) standards appear in Subpart Z. In order to obtain the NC OSHA standards, you must go to <http://ncrules.state.nc.us/ncadministrativ /title13labor /chapter07 /default.htm>. Go to Title 13-Labor, Chapter 07, Subchapter F, Subchapter F Rules to view the OSHA standards for airborne contaminants. If your copy of the NC OSHA standards is dated April 2003 or later, the NC OSHA standards for airborne contaminants are incorporated into the manual. Please review the exposure limits in this table to be sure the NC OSHA standard for airborne contaminants has been incorporated.
