Dear Mr. Challeen:

OHM Remediation Services Corp. (OHM), understands that soils, debris and drums are to be removed from the four proposed excavations, staged and disposed of according to 40 CFR 262 and 268. OHM's analysis of the waste will determine if it is hazardous based on characteristics (D waste). Do you, or any individuals associated with the base know or anticipated the presence of listed waste codes (F,K,P, or U) in the excavated material. If so, what waste codes are anticipated?

Listed waste codes may require additional analysis and/or special disposal conditions not evaluated in the cost estimate. Advance notice will enable OHM to make arrangements for handling the above mentioned waste codes. Your help in addressing this matter is deeply appreciated.
