1. The Installation Restoration Division, Environmental Management Department at Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune has identified 20 additional potential hazardous waste sites that require further investigation. The 20 sites consist of six laundry/dry cleaning facilities, eight vehicle maintenance shops, five automobile hobby shops, and one furniture repair shop. These sites are listed in the "Plant Account Facilities Inventory Listing of Buildings & Structures, 30 June 1990, Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina." Enclosure 1 is compiled from that list.

2. It is requested that these sites be placed in the Installation Restoration Program as "Preliminary Assessment/Site Investigation" sites. There is no indication that these 20 sites were identified or examined by the Navy Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants as part of the Initial Assessment Study of 1983. Similar operations and activities at other facilities aboard Camp Lejeune and Marine Corps Air Station, New River have exhibited environmental contamination.
