The NC Superfund Section has received and reviewed the Draft Site Management Plan (SMP) dated July 2008, for Camp Lejeune, MCB Superfund Site. The following comments are included for the Partnering Teams consideration.

Specific Comments

1. The Section of the report that discussed the Phase III Non-Time Critical Removal Action (NTCRA) on page 3-32 also discusses areas that were contaminated with PCBs greater than 10 PPM where excavation was impracticable. Please clarify the location of the general areas where PCBs exceeded 10 PPM and were impracticable to excavate. I think that the main area being referred to is the Utility corridor near the Power Sub-Station. This isn't too much detail and may help locate the area in the future as needed. It also clarifies that it wasn't the entire Phase III removal area.
2. Many of the schedule Tables 3-xx need the dates to be re-evaluated since some have not been met. See Tables 3-12 and 3-13.

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
