General Comments

1. The State concurs with the responses to comments with the exception of comment #3.

Comment #3. Section 5.3 on page 5-2 states that no samples will be collected in the wetlands. We should definitely be taking some samples in the tributaries to the wetland and Bearhead Creek.

Response:

Surface water and sediment samples will be collected in Bearhead Creek to evaluate if Bearhead Creek has been impacted by operations at the skeet range. The Work Plan has been revised to state that none of the proposed soil samples will be collected within the wetland area.

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
It is not clear whether surface soil samples, sediment samples, and surface water samples will be collected in the tributaries to the creek and wetland areas. I noted in a reconnaissance of the D-9 Skeet Range that at least 3 tributaries drain the site to the west and at least one to the east side. We cannot clear of the site without confirming the tributaries. If the tributaries are not contaminated then the wetlands and creek are most likely clean as well unless there is another source.
