The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the above subject document, dated November, 2011 and agrees with the recommendations. The recommendations include: no further investigation for phase I, additional digital geophysical mapping (DGM) and intrusive investigations beyond the boundaries of the defined UXO-21 area and no further investigation of site media. EPA also agrees with the need of a 100% intrusive investigation if this area is slated for construction and a re-evaluation of the environmental media after completion of the additional DGM and intrusive investigations.
