In Section 7.2, Recommendations, it states that "At the former Indoor Pistol Range, an interim removal action or a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study, or both, is recommended to reduce or mitigate potential human health and ecological exposure to antimony and lead in surface and subsurface soil".
