General Comment

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the above subject document, dated March 2008. The data should be screened using the new "Regional Screening levels for Chemical Contaminants at Superfund Sites". This replaces the use of the Region 9 Preliminary Remediation Goals for risk assessments; accordingly, the text should be corrected. Upon making the corrections this document can be finalized.

The text has been modified to reflect that the *Regional Screening Levels for Chemical Contaminants at Superfund Sites* will be used for data screening instead of the Region 9 PRGs.
