The NC Superfund Section concurs with the request to shut down deep recovery well DRW-1 for the proposed microcosm study in this area. The NC Superfund Section has no concerns about the capture of contaminants located at DRW-1 since based on the groundwater flow direction in the area, recovery wells DRW-2, DRW-3 and DRW-4 would capture the contaminants in this area. However, the high concentrations of CVOCs located in the area of DRW-1 if left alone for several years would eventually travel to the creek or be extended to DRW-04. Therefore, a definitive action should be taken within the one year period or the extraction well turned back on.
