The NC Superfund Section has received and reviewed the Draft Expanded Site Inspection, UFP-SAP, for Site UXO-23 - D-9 Skeet Range at the Camp Lejeune, MCB Superfund Site. The document is dated August 2012 and received by the NC Superfund Section on 23 August 2012. The following comment is included for the Partnering Teams consideration.

**Specific Comments**

1. In reading through the Sediment and Surface Water Sample location descriptions and locations on page 34 and 35 it was observed that Figure 7 is not consistent with these descriptions. According to Figure 7 there are 6 sediment samples in Section 1, not 5; 7 sediment samples in Section 2, not 10; 9 samples in section 3, not 10; 6 samples in Section 4, not 10 and 3 samples in section 5, not 15. Please make appropriate corrections in this section and throughout the Plan.
2. Item number 11 on page 2 of the Low-Flow Groundwater Sampling SOP in Appendix B is inconsistent with CH2M Hills recent discussion of minimal hydraulic conductivity for low-flow sampling based on the EPAs SESD procedures dated October 2011. Please make corrections in item number 11 to be consistent with recent discussions and responses to comments and as we discussed in the June partnering meeting.
