The Superfund Section of the Division of Waste Management has completed its review of the Draft Expanded Site Inspection Report for the Off-Base Surface Danger Zones, received on March 27, 2014.

We concur with the conclusions and recommendations made in the report. Specifically in Section 7.3, Recommendations, it states that it is recommended that the area for future investigation and possible action to mitigate potential munitions be reduced to the southwestern portion of the MRA where MEC was found, near the former Browns Island target area. To this end, it is recommended that an Engineering Evaluation/Cost Assessment (EE/CA) be prepared to evaluate future actions and alternatives for this area.
