The NC Superfund Section has received and reviewed the Draft FY2015 Site Management Plan (SMP) dated November 2014 and received for review by NC Superfund on November 21, 2014. The SMP is in good order. The following comments are included for the Partnering Teams consideration.

**Specific Comments**

1. Operable Unit 22, Site 96 is listed on Table 2-2 and the Site Description states Building 1817 UST. Is this Building 1817 or Building 1827? Please confirm. It has been listed in other documents at building 1827.
2. Table 2-3 lists the Final ROD date as April 24, 2104. Please make appropriate changes.
3. Table 2-3 does not include a RD/RA Column. Do we not keep track of our RD/RAs in the SMP? I recommend that we remove the PRAP Column and Replace it with the RD/RA Dates.
4. Table 2-4 lists Site UXO-29 as proposing a PA/SI for the follow-up work. The UXO-29 MILCON identified high explosives (HE) and other MEC & MPPEH throughout the Area. We should probably complete the investigation of this Site as an RI since LUCs will be required. Check page 3-6 Section 3.1.3.1; Future Activities.
5. Please change NC Route 24 to 17 Bypass in Section 4.1.1 on page 4-1.
6. Schedule 4-1 has not been realized. This may be true of a number of work schedules for the FY2015 SMP. Please update all schedules as needed in the Final SMP.
