Restoration Advisory Board Meeting Five-Year Review Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune North Carolina

The Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCB CAMLEJ) Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meets quarterly to discuss the Base's Environmental Restoration Program with the local community. You are invited to the next RAB meeting to learn more about the Environmental Restoration Program and the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) Five-Year Review as described below. This RAB meeting will be held on **Wednesday November 18, 2015 at 6:00 PM** at the following location:

Five-Year Review: The Department of the Navy, MCB CAMLEJ, and United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), with concurrence from North Carolina Department of Environment Quality (NCDEQ), completed a Five-Year Review of environmental cleanup actions at MCB CAMLEJ. The Five-Year Review is required by Section 121 of CERCLA to ensure that environmental cleanup actions are adequately protecting human health and the environment at sites where any hazardous substances, pollutants, or contaminants remain in-place while cleanup is ongoing. The Five-Year Review indicated all ongoing remedial actions at MCB CAMLEJ are protecting human health and the environment. The review also provided recommendations to ensure some remedies will continue to be protective in the long run. The next Five-Year Review is scheduled for 2020.
