**RECORD OF DECISION AVAILABLE FOR  
OPERABLE UNIT 25, SITE UXO-19 AT  
MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP LEJEUNE  
NORTH CAROLINA**

The United States Department of the Navy announces the availability of the Record of Decision (ROD) for Operable Unit 25 (OU 25), Site UXO-19, located aboard Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCB Camp Lejeune).

The ROD documents the Navy's selected remedy for addressing potential contamination from past use and/or disposal of munitions at the site. The selected remedy consists of Land Use Controls, such as warning signs, training, and restrictions on ground-disturbing activities. The remedy is protective of human health and the environment. The effectiveness of this remedy will be reviewed every five years.

Prior to selecting the remedy, a public meeting and comment period were held and only questions for informational purposes were received. The ROD has been reviewed and approved by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ).
