Gentlemen:

This letter is in regard to the disposition of stockpiled soil for the referenced contract. As discussed during a telephone conversation between LT Challeen and Mr. Kent Gies on 9 March 1994, the Government intends to return stockpiled soil to the trenches it originated from as long as: 1) the soil is not RCRA hazardous, and 2) the TPH concentration does not adversely affect human health or the environment.

Based on laboratory analysis, the soil from the two southern trenches is not hazardous, and has elevated TPH concentrations in only one location. The portions of the stockpile that do not exceed 1,650 ppm may be returned to the two southern trenches, and may be identified through field screening. Ensure the field screening procedure is well documented and included in your final report. If contaminated areas cannot be identified through field screening, inform our office, and we will determine options which may include further laboratory analysis. Soils with elevated TPH concentrations must remain in the soil containment cell and be processed for thermal treatment.

Once we receive laboratory analysis for the soils excavated from the northern trenches, we will discuss its disposition jointly with LANTDIV, EMD, OHM, and Baker Environmental. The Government desires to return this soil to the excavations if it is non-hazardous, but must evaluate its remediation potential using soil vapor extraction.
