Thank you for your comments concerning Installation Restoration Program Site 12, the Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD-1) site. Since July 1998, the United States Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE), St. Louis District has been under contract with Headquarters United States Marine Corps to inventory ranges at Marine Corps bases. We are coordinating with the ACOE for them to evaluate Site 12 with respect to metals and unexploded ordnance for inclusion in the Range Survey.

The Range Survey focuses on listing ordnance and training activities that have occurred at Camp Lejeune since its establishment. Specifically, this work involves conducting Archive Search Reports (ASRs) and Range Identification and Preliminary Range Assessments of Ordnance and Explosives ranges through the process. We will inform you later this summer as to changes in status of site.
