Concerning the Camp Geiger Fuel Farm, enclosed is one copy of the "Final Report, Underground Fuel Investigation Comprehensive Site Assessment" and one copy of the "Addendum to Report of Underground Fuel Investigation and Comprehensive Site Assessment" for your review and approval. Results of the site assessment indicate petroleum contaminated groundwater. However, contamination of the groundwater by chlorinated compounds was also discovered. Due to the chlorinated compound contamination of the groundwater, further work at this site in the Underground Storage Tank Program will discontinue. Continued investigation and remediation of this site will be performed under the Installation Restoration Program. Both Mr. Patrick Waters, North Carolina Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Superfund Section, and Ms. Gena Townsend, Environmental Protection Agency, Region IV, have been notified of this transfer.
