1. Page 16, SW and GW investigation - This section states, "vocs, pesticides and metals were detected". A sentence should be added to emphasize that the detected contaminants are below regulatory limits.
2. Page 18, Soil - RAA2 is greater than RAA3, is this correct?
3. Page 24, Inorganic Section, 3rd bullet – Word missing from sentence.
4. Page 24, Last paragraph – "However" should be removed from the sentence.
5. Page 28 – Correct date and location for the public information meeting.
6. Add land use restrictions to sites 43 & 44.
