After reviewing section 3.5 of the above mentioned document, I offer the following comment:

1. On page 7-20 of the Final RI, section 7.10.1, third paragraph, it is stated that "The high pesticide concentration in the surface water and sediment may be due to disposal of excess materials during the periodic pesticide spraying that occurred on the base". However, according to page 18 of the ROD, Aquatic Ecosystems section, first paragraph, "However, pesticides reportedly were never stored or disposed at Site 43". Please explain these contradictory statements.
