1. The Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) of 1986 required Federal facilities to identify hazardous waste sites and provide EPA with information necessary for HRS scoring of sites by 17 April 1988. Sites that score above 28.5 using the HRS qualify for inclusion on the National Priorities List (NPL), a list of the worst hazardous waste sites in the country. We amended our existing Confirmation Study contracts to prepare this documentation, and the final HRS scoring package is enclosed. A copy of the HRS scoring package was also sent to EPA on 14 April 1988 as per reference (a). Our contractor's ranking of the five sites at MCAS New River indicates three sites exceeded 28.5. The sites ranked as follows:
