Baker Environmental, Inc. (Baker) is pleased to submit one bound copy and one unbound copy of the Final Remedial Investigation (RI) Report for Operable Unit OU 19, Site 84/Building 45 Area. Copies of the report have also been forwarded to members of the Partnering Team.

The Final RI addresses the written comments provided by the Partnering Team and additional comments discussed during the April 26, 2002 conference call. All comments were addressed as documented in the response to comments letter dated May 6, 2002.

Based on the comments we received on the draft, the RI includes proceeding with the non-Time Critical Removal Action (non-TCRA) scheduled to begin in June 2002 and a groundwater monitoring program for the metals, BTEX, and pesticides. As demonstrated in the human health risk assessment, completion of the non-TCRA will reduce site risks, leaving the Feasibility Study (FS) to address remaining site contamination.

This submission includes an entire new Volume I. Volume II (appendices) required only minimal changes from the draft, therefore inserts are provided along with instructions for replacement. As always, Baker appreciates


