The NC Superfund Section has received and reviewed the OU #18 (Site 94) Draft Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP) for the Camp Lejeune, MCB Superfund Site located in Jacksonville, NC. The following comments are offered for the Work Teams consideration. If you have any questions or comments please contact me at (919) 508 8467.

General Comment

It is recommended that a Conclusions or Site Details Section be included in the Introductory Section of the PRAP. This new Section of the PRAP should include the paragraph from Section 3.2 of the PRAP that states that: "Site 94 is not a source of, nor a contributor to the chlorinated VOCs that are currently observed in the site soil and groundwater within the shallow, intermediate, and deep zones. The chlorinated VOC plume detected at Site 94 appears to be migrating from an adjacent IR Site west within the intermediate zone, which ultimately discharges to the New River. The vertical migration of the TCE plume has impacted both the intermediate aquifer unit and the deep aquifer. This plume is being handled under the remedial action for the adjacent IR Site."

This paragraph could be included in the Introductory Section. The details of the adjacent site contamination are very important to communicate as soon as possible in the report, since TCE observed during the UST investigation was the reason for establishing a new Site (Site 94) for investigation.


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Specific Comments

1. Section 7.3 of the PRAP includes the Administrative Record Web page address for document review by the public. In attempting to verify the Administrative Records on the http://www.bakerenv.com/camplejeune_irp/ Web site which contains the Information Repository for the Base's IR Site work, I could not get the Remedial Investigation (RI) Report to come up from the Repository Web page. Please make sure that the RI Report and all data files and other PA/SI data and UST data, etc. are available, for Site 94, on the **Administrative Records files** before the 30 day comment period starts.
