Attached for your review is the Draft-Final FY10 SMP for MCAS Cherry Point in PDF format. All team comments on the Draft SMP have been incorporated into this Draft-Final. Text changes are shown in the PDF in redline/strikeout fashion. There were no changes to any of the figures. Regarding tables, some comments impacted the SMP schedule (Table 5-2), which had cascading impacts on some of the other tables. Revisions were made only to the following tables:

- 3-1
- 3-2
- 3-3
- 5-1
- 5-2

I need to point out something for team consideration that was revealed during consideration of one of the team comments. The issue pertains to OU2, Site 46. Currently, the SMP indicates in the text and tables that the partnering team agreed at the December 2006-meeting to modify the LUC boundaries for OU2 to exclude Site 46 (polishing ponds), excepting the "finger" area downgradient of Site 46. There is a letter to EPA from NAVFAC requesting approval of this LUC change. However, if you read the December 2006 meeting minutes, it indicates in more than one place that the team not only agreed to change the LUC boundaries, but also agreed to remove Site 46 entirely from OU2. The letter I mentioned does not indicate that Site 46 was being removed entirely from the OU, only that the LUC boundaries were to be changed. While the decision to remove Site 46 from OU2, if truly intended, is not reflected in the text or tables of the D-F SMP, I noted that Figure 3-4 showing the features o

f OU2 does not include Site 46 within the indicated OU2 boundary (nor the LUC boundaries). It has been this way for at least the last couple of FY SMPs. So - my question is whether or not Site 46 is still part of OU2 or whether only the LUC boundaries in the remedy were modified. If it was intended that Site 46 be removed from OU2, do the meeting minutes constitute adequate documentation/approval of this action? Please let me know your thoughts. If any changes to the SMP are necessary based on the outcome of this issue, I can make revisions for the Final SMP.

I have set a tentative target date for a team response to the Draft-Final SMP of July 31. The changes are not particularly extensive, so I am hoping it is a relatively easy and non-time-consuming review.
