EPA comments on the Draft OU14 FS. In addition, we have prepared and attached redline/strikeout versions of the text and tables that show the proposed edits in response to the comments. With regard to the text and table files, please note that some additional proposed edits have been made in response to comments from the Navy attorney and also to correct some typos discovered during the editing process. With regard to the tables, only the tables containing proposed edits have been included in the PDF - all other tables remain unchanged from the Draft FS. Also, please ignore the page numbering in the Tables PDF file - the Final report will have pagination (e.g., "Page 1 of 2") based on the individual tables, not the set. Finally, one of the EPA comments pointed out a typo in Figure 2-6. Page 5-3, Section 5.2.2.

The EPA & NC lawyers have agreed that NCGS 143B-279.9 and 297.10 should be used as the references in the TBC list. The Notice is now called "Notice of Contaminated Site". I believe the EPA lawyer's ARARs comments included these references.

\*The OU14, Site 90 PRAP should also be changed to reference NCGS  
143B-279.9 and 143B-279.10\*

As clarification,  
The NCGS 130 and 143B basically say the same thing but deal with different  
programs in NCDENR. The lawyers feel 143B is the better reference NOW!
