To ensure the protection of human health and the environment, the enclosed temporary emergency RCRA permit application is submitted for your approval. The enclosure supports the Expanded Site Inspection effort including the treatment and disposal of solid waste generated during range clearing activities on Wood Island, North Carolina, site of the Former Cat Island Bomb Target BT-2 associated with Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point. Extensive coordination is on going with the NC Superfund Section and the Environmental Protection Agency.

It is anticipated that this field effort will commence in October 2010. However, as this effort is contingent upon numerous agency approvals, the exact start date of the effort is not currently known. MCAS Cherry Point will coordinate with the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources (NCDENR) regarding the start date of the 90-day temporary emergency RCRA permit once the start date has been determined.
