Dear Mr. Lank:

In accordance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act 3008(h) Consent Order, please find enclosed the Draft Work Plan for Sites 5, 10, 16, and 17. This is the same Work Plan provided to Technical Review Committee (TRC) meeting attendees in April 1989. Also find enclosed the Soil Gas Survey Final Report. The Draft Work Plan has been updated to reflect additional well locations and soil borings for investigation of soil gas anomalies. In accordance with previous agreement with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Work Plan was written to meet the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) requirements and utilizes CERCLA terminology.

Because funding must be committed in Fiscal Year 1990, we request you review and comment as soon as possible on the Work Plan. Additional Work Plans will be submitted within the 180-day timeframes in accordance with the Consent Order. To avoid funding expiration, please provide your written comments within 30 days of receipt.


