Dear Sir:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 4 has reviewed the above subject decision documents and concurs with the selected remedy for Operable Units 4 and 13. This remedy is supported by the previously completed Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study and Baseline Risk Assessment Reports.

The selected remedial alternatives include monitored natural attenuation and land use controls for groundwater. The land use controls will restrict groundwater usage and prohibit intrusive activities within the extent of current groundwater contamination. This remedial action is protective of human health and the environment, complies with Federal and State requirements that are legally applicable or relevant and appropriate to the remedial action and is cost effective.

EPA appreciates the coordination efforts of MCAS Cherry Point and the level of effort that was put forth in the documents leading to this decision. EPA looks forward to continuing the exemplary working relationship with MCAS Cherry Point and Atlantic Division Naval Facilities Engineering Command as we move toward a final cleanup of the NPL site.
