I am writing to solicit your assistance in caring for our environment here in Eastern North Carolina--specifically aboard Marine Corps Auxiliary Landing Field (MCALF Bogue).

The Air Station is establishing a Technical Review Committee (TRC) for review of investigation and remediation activities at the Former Crash Crew Burn Pit located at MCALF Bogue, North Carolina. This site is presently under the investigation phase of work under the Navy Installation Restoration (IR) Program.

As you are aware, we appoint a community representative to each of the TRCs to ensure that both regulatory and local community interests are incorporated into any planned IR Program activities.


After reviewing numerous potential appointees, I feel your interests and qualifications would greatly benefit the TRC and the IR Program for MCALF Bogue.

I would like to take this opportunity to invite you to join the TRC for MCALF Bogue as the local community representative. Should you choose to accept the appointment, your first TRC activity will be to participate in the TRC meeting tentatively scheduled for July 31, 1991, at the Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point. The meeting agenda will include a tour of the site at MCALF Bogue and review of a report on investigations conducted to date at the burn pit. Planned future investigation activities will also be discussed.

Your input on the TRC would materially enhance our efforts both to provide for our constitutionally mandated common defense and to promote the Department of Defense mandate to care for our environment. May we hear from you regarding your decision by July 17th? We can then send you information related to the upcoming meeting and a meeting agenda.
