> Michelle and George:
>

> We have been making arrangements to move forward with the RI fieldwork
> at OU14 (Site 90), the chlorinated VOC plume in the vicinity of Hangar
> 130. However, I wanted to make sure we have all our ducks lined up, so
> to speak. We had received regulatory concurrence on the RTC for the
> Draft RI Work Plan in August and submitted earlier this month the Final
> RI Work Plan that incorporated those agreed upon responses to comments.
> I don't have any records indicating that the State and EPA had
> officially approved the Work Plan, so I wanted to see where your
> agencies stood with respect to the Work Plan. We don't want to move much
> further with respect to making arrangements to start the fieldwork if
> the Work Plans have not been approved.

> We have tentatively scheduled the fieldwork to begin at OU14 on Tuesday,
> October 8. Obviously, we will hold off on that if you have any concerns
> about the Work Plan. Please let me know if you have any concerns with us
> moving forward to start the fieldwork.
>

> I believe both of you had expressed interest in observing the fieldwork.
> Assuming that we are able to begin the work on October 8 as tentatively
> scheduled, we anticipate that the fieldwork will continue until about
> October 18. The work will consist of direct-push soil and groundwater
> sampling. We would be happy to have you stop by to observe the work.
>

> Please let me know your thoughts on the Work Plan and moving forward
> with the field work. Do not hesitate to call if you would like to
> discuss any of these issues.
