Subj: **RAB MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT**

The next Crane Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center (NSWC Crane) Community Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, June 5, 2001. The meeting will take place on Center in the main dining room at the Lakeview Training and Conference Center, in Crane, Indiana from 1200 to 1600 hours.

RAB meetings are open to members of the public and are intended to help the general public learn how NAVSURFWARCENDIV Crane is conducting environmental cleanups using proven and alternative technologies. The RAB at Crane is a forum for exchange of information and partnership among citizens of the surrounding communities with DoD, and environmental oversight agencies. Most importantly, the RAB will offer an opportunity for the communities to provide input to the cleanup process. The goal is to create a dialogue between the installation and the effected communities.

The agenda for the meeting will include, status updates on current Corrective Action activities including the Explosives Contaminated Soils Bioremediation Facility, Soils Background Metals Report, Mine Fill A Battery Dump Site, and Roads & Grounds Cleanup. Continued discussion of the Natural Attenuation Demonstration. RAB member final approval of the NSWC Crane RAB website, which will be available by May 22, 2001 and located at <http://www.crane.navy.mil/General/Environmental/environment.htm>. Updates on an assortment of workplans and fieldwork currently underway. The annual Environmental Restoration, Navy projects budget proposed for Fiscal Year 02 will be presented and discussed. Overview of the RAB conference attended by the Community Co-Chair. Additional ideas and input for topics or presentations are especially welcome.

Furthermore, since the meeting coincides with the afternoon meal, a working lunch has been planned. The meal will consist of a Turkey club sandwich, chips, pickle spear, and a cookie served with coffee or iced tea. The cost of the meal will be \$6.50, gratuity is included; other beverages are extra. Please make your reservation by May 29, 2001.
