The Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management, Office of Waste Management (RIDEM) has reviewed Appendix N (Digital Geophysical Investigation Plan) of the above referenced document as you requested in your 15 October 2010 email. The remainder of the document will be reviewed at a later date. Comments for Appendix N are provided below:

1. Page N-10, Section 5.0, Data Processing, Bullet 10 - This bullet states that the threshold will be based on the smallest expected item which is an 81 mm mortar. During the late 1070's and early 1980's this site was used as a 25 m rifle range. Please state the size of the bullets for the rifles. If smaller than 81 mm then the threshold should be adjusted to the size of the smallest bullet used.
2. Page N-12, Section 5.0, Data Maps - In addition to the bullets listing the information for the maps, a scale would also be helpful.
3. Page N-15, Section 6.0, Data deliverables - Please define "IVS". This acronym is not contained in the list of acronyms.
4. Page N-20, Section 10.1.1, Munitions and Explosives of Concern Target Detection, Burial Depths and Removal Objectives - This section notes the smallest target is the 81 mm mortar and implied 3.5" rockets. Please see comment #1 above.
